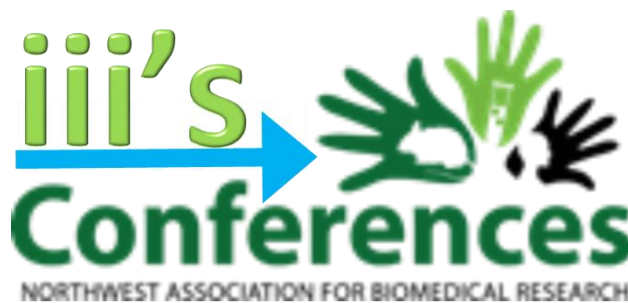


Join Us for a Biomedical
