This position serves as a liaison and subject matter expert between the IACUC, IBC, and other integrity programs as needed, to assure smooth and coordinated review processes for protocols involving animal subjects, recombinant DNA, and/or other hazardous agents.

**Qualifications:** Bachelor's degree in a related scientific discipline, 4 years of related experience. Advanced degree and advanced knowledge in federal and state laws, regulations, and guidance relating to research and related areas preferred.
